

LEARNING FROM EACH OTHER!

Sun City in Huntley, Illinois is an Active Adult Del Webb Community of 5,481 independent homes with 41 neighborhoods. Now a FirstService Residential property, Shannon is the Lifestyle Assistant for the Homeowners Association, tasked with planning classes, movie days, concerts, and bus tours for their 10,000 or so residents. Her supervisor, Melissa Hornick, Lifestyle Manager, plans large events such as concerts and luncheons that are held there. They also have two fitness centers, one indoor and two outdoor pools, a walking track, and 50 charter clubs that plan activities. As one resident recently told Shannon, "Nobody could ever be bored here."

An active community of residents age 55 or older, some residents still work while others are free to play all day. The trips Shannon plans for them include most of The Fireside's shows, other theatres in the region, ball games, gardens, boat cruises, concerts, and historic destinations. They also have some that are transportation only, like Christmas shopping in Chicago or a day at Navy Pier.

Their planning structure is a little different than most groups we work with. Shannon has a team of 10 resident volunteers that actually help choose and coordinate the trips. They plan the date, logistics, timing, and meals then turn things over to Shannon to sign the contracts, make payments, secure the motorcoach, and handle advertising and promotion.

Melissa and Shannon submit their activity information to the staff who create their monthly magazine that each home receives. Then on the first business day of each month residents can make their reservations with full payment either online or in person for any new events, usually about three months in advance. Some trips sell out right away so they keep a waiting list they can share with a resident if they find later on that they're unable to attend - then the resident will find their own substitute. On trip day, the volunteer assigned to that tour will be the escort, utilizing the complimentary escort ticket. Sun City doesn't make any profit on their trips, they just make sure to cover their costs.

I'm always working in the future. It may be August but my brain is in December!"


This system works very well for them, with the online sign-up being a really nice option. While Shannon hasn't been to The Fireside yet, she loves making sure her residents get here, noting that there are some who sign up for every Fireside tour as soon as they can. She also enjoys her role in keeping people active. "I love all of the people here," she remarked. "Everyone has a fun story and I love getting to know them. There are so many great people in this world!"





There are recipes for pecan pie dating back as early as

1886 with many of the better known cookbooks including it in the 1940's. Speculation is that French settlers in New Orleans created it after being introduced to the pecan by Native Americans. The makers of Karo Syrup contributed to popularizing the pecan pie in 1930 when the company claimed it was a corporate executive's wife who

discovered it as "a new use for the corn syrup."

Whether that's true or not, our mix of corn syrup, vanilla, brown sugar, eggs, and butter make an excellent custard

beneath the pecans. Served with a Dark Rum Caramel Sauce and topped with Fresh Whipped Cream, we know you'll enjoy every bite!



Hold seating with a small deposit while you finalize your count, due four weeks before your visit. For weekday matinees, 18 paid tickets earns a complimentary package. For all other shows every 20 paid tickets earns a comp. There is plenty of safe, free parking on-site for coaches and cars. The Fireside is accessible to guests with disabilities. Please let us know what special needs you have when making reservations.

- The three-course dinner and show for groups of 13 or more is \$84.93 (\$80.50 tax exempt) per person.
